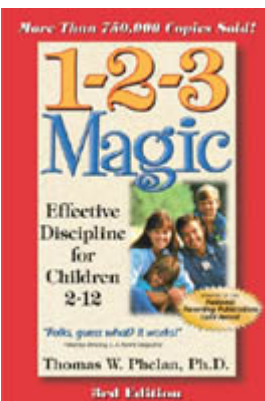
1-2-3 Magic & More
